



The Dr. Nancy Kellogg Golden Heart Award Of South Texas

Awarded by ChildSafe in San Antonio, TX

About the Award

ChildSafe, Bexar County's Child Advocacy, is proud to announce this annual award in recognition of excellence in the field of child abuse and child protection in South Texas. The award is named after Nancy Kellogg, M.D., ChildSafe's first Medical Director who is nationally and internationally recognized for her work in the field of child abuse. The award will be presented every December at ChildSafe's Child Abuse Conference which is held in San Antonio, TX. It acknowledges outstanding achievements made by individuals, groups or companies which encourage and have a positive, direct impact on any of the following:

- **child and family well-being** via programs, services, outreach efforts, or public policy which serve to reduce, eliminate or prevent child abuse/neglect.
- **child abuse awareness and education** via programs, services, outreach efforts, or public policy.
- **medical and/or mental health treatment of abused/neglected children** via successful and supportive programs, services, or outreach efforts.

Nominations

ChildSafe seeks nominations of individuals, groups or companies who have had a positive, direct impact in the field of child abuse and child protection on any of three levels:

- Personal – individual knowledge or skills which positively impact or enhance/advance the field of child abuse and/or child protection.
- Community – significantly improves a community via child abuse prevention efforts and/or the promotion of child/family well being to reduce or eliminate child abuse.
- Regional – positively impacts the South Texas region by changing public policies or social views, norms, etc. in favor of child abuse prevention/awareness, child protection and family well-being.

Nominees can include:

1. An **individual** such as a community member, volunteer, political figure, child advocate, law enforcement officer or other professional whose efforts have significantly contributed to the field of child abuse and child protection.
2. A **group** of individuals working together as a volunteer group, parent organization, etc., whose efforts have significantly contributed to the field of child abuse and child protection
3. A **company** such as a small business, firm or corporation whose efforts have significantly contributed to the field of child abuse and child protection.

Nominations for the Dr. Nancy Kellogg Golden Heart Award will be accepted beginning April 1, 2010 thru September 1, 2010 for the 2010 calendar year. This award will be given at ChildSafe's 2010 Child Abuse Conference, December 13-14, 2010 (Norris Conference Center, San Antonio, TX). Self-nominations are accepted. Nominations cannot be accepted after the closing date of September 1, 2010.
