A Fundraising Program for Non-Profits designed by Golf San Antonio

San Antonio 11•7•11...Birdies for Charity® is a fundraising program designed by Golf San Antonio to give organizations the opportunity to generate contributions through the Valero Texas Open. Birdies for Charity is a no-cost program that gives 100% of the funds raised back to the participating organizations. Funds are generated by soliciting pledges from individuals and corporations.

Birdies for Charity is like a walk-a-thon, but instead of donating per mile, participants make a pledge for every birdie made at the Valero Texas Open. The 2011 Valero Texas Open had 1,950 birdies made, so a pledge of \$0.01 yielded a donation of \$19.50.

**ChildSafe, the only advocacy center in the area for child victims of sexual abuse, is requesting support from individuals and companies to pledge as follows to sustain their vital programs:**

- **Corporations: \$0.50+ (per birdie made)**
- **Individuals: \$0.01+ (per birdie made)**

Donors also have the ability to make a one-time donation and flexibility to pay in advance or be billed after the tournament. Donations are accepted from anywhere around the world and **are tax deductible.**
